Permit to appropriate Public Waters of the State of Washington

Book No. 36 of Permits, on Page 14229 Under Application No. 19132

GEORGE F. & VIVIAN A. WOLF, ET AL

of Quileene, Washington

is hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights and to the following limitations and provisions: Permittee shall construct and maintain at his own expense a weir, or other suitable device, for measuring any water granted herein for irrigation purposes and such appropriation shall be subject to a reasonable rotation system if ordered by the State Supervisor of Water Resources. (1) Diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire having a mesh opening not greater than 0.125 (1/8) inch. (2) "Issued as a supplemental supply to Surface Water Certificate No. 2729, the total annual diversion under both rights shall not exceed 13.2 acre-feet."

Priority date of this permit is July 21, 1965

Source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream
tributary of Quileene Bay

The quantity of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially applied and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, to be used for the following purposes: group domestic supply

In Gov't Lot 1 and Gov't Lot 2, Sec. 25, T. 27 N., R. 2 W.W.M.:

GEORGE F. WOLF PROPERTY

Parcel 1: Beginning at the northwest corner of Gov't Lot 2; thence south $07^{\circ}00'$ west along meander line 300 feet to point of beginning; thence continuing south $07^{\circ}00'$ west 200 feet; thence west to the easterly right of way line of county road; thence north $18^{\circ}15'$ west along said line to a point lying west of point of beginning; thence east to point of beginning.

Parcel 2: Beginning at the intersection of the easterly right of way line of county road and the north line of Gov't Lot 2; thence south $18^{\circ}15'$ east 209.02 feet along said right of way line to the true point of beginning; thence east 477.15 feet to the meander line; thence south $07^{\circ}00'$ west along meander line 100 feet; thence west to said easterly right of way line; thence north $18^{\circ}15'$ west along said line to point of beginning.

Parcel 3: The north 100 feet of the south 200 feet of that portion of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the county road.

Parcel 4: The north 100 feet of the south 300 feet of that portion of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the county road.

DREW C. AMO PROPERTY

Parcel 1: Beginning at the intersection of the north line of Gov't Lot 1 and the westerly right of way of county road, said point being 88.1 feet west from the meander corner; thence west along north line of Sec. 25 727.5 feet to the north quarter corner of said section; thence south along centerline of said section 416.4 feet; thence east 945.0 feet more or less to said west line of county road; thence northwesterly along said west line to point of beginning.

Parcel 2: That part of the south 280.0 feet of Gov't Lot 1 lying westerly of the right of way of the county road.

Parcel 3: That part of Gov't Lot 2 lying westerly of the right of way of the county road, EXCEPT: that part of the following described tract lying westerly of said right of way: beginning at the southeast corner of said Gov't Lot 2; thence west 1500 feet; thence north 150 feet; thence east to the meander line; thence southeasterly along meander line to point of beginning.

KENNETH H. HARRIS PROPERTY:

Parcel 1: The south 100 feet of the north 200 feet of the south 500 feet of that portion of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the right of way of the county road.

Parcel 2: The north 100 feet of the south 500 feet of that portion of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the right of way of the county road.

Parcel 3: That part of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the right of way of the county road; LESS the south 500 feet thereof; AND LESS beginning at the meander corner on the north line of said Sec. 25; thence south $45^{\circ}43'$ east 798.96 feet; thence west to said right of way; thence north to north line of said section; thence east to point of beginning.

BYRON REEVES PROPERTY:

Parcel 1: That part of the south 642.15 feet of the north 1058.55 feet of Gov't Lot 1 lying westerly of the right of way of the county road.

Parcel 2: Beginning at the northeast corner of Gov't Lot 2; thence south $07^{\circ}00'$ west 100 feet; thence west to right of way of the county road; thence south $18^{\circ}15'$ along said right of way 104.51 feet; thence east to meander line; thence north $07^{\circ}00'$ east along said meander line 100 feet to point of beginning.

JULIAN T. OEN PROPERTY: The south 100 feet of that portion of Gov't Lot 1 lying easterly of the right of way of the county road.

JOHN W. RINTA PROPERTY: Beginning at the northeast corner of Gov't Lot 2; thence west 566.99 feet to right of way of the county road; thence south $18^{\circ}15'$ east along said right of way 104.51 feet; thence east 477.15 feet to the meander line; thence north $07^{\circ}00'$ east along the meander line 100 feet to point of beginning.

RICHARD R. BORDEN PROPERTY: Beginning at the northeast corner of Gov't Lot 2; thence south $07^{\circ}00'$ west along the meander line 500 feet to true point of beginning; thence continuing south $07^{\circ}00'$ west along the meander line 200 feet; thence west to right of way of the county road; thence northwesterly along said right of way to a point which lies west of the true point of beginning; thence east to true point of beginning.
