

**CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF
USE OF WATER**

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and rules thereunder for the State Supervisor of the Division of Water Resources.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY: That John D. Burrows of Walla Walla, Washington, has complied with all of the requirements of Section 90.28 .090 Revised Code of Washington, and is hereby granted a permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of waters of Stone Creek in the amount of 0.00894 second-foot, being a portion of the amount as granted in Certificate No. 3 in Cause No. 15409, State of Washington vs. Carmen Alessio et al; that said water had been diverted from a point situated near the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M., that the point of diversion has been changed to a point situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M., such point being one mile above the former point of diversion.

That the water had been used for irrigation on the following described lands:

Beginning at the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 32, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M., running thence along the north and south center line of said section south 40 chains to the center point of said section; thence along the east and west center line of said section west 18 chains; thence north 9°45' west 25.45 chains to a point in the center of the south channel of Stone Creek where the northerly boundary line of the two tracts of land sold by A. Blackhall to M. Villa run together; thence north 48°30' east 19.71 chains to a point in the center of Stone Creek; thence following and meandering said creek upward in its center to a point where the northerly boundary line of Section 32 in T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M. crosses said center line of Stone Creek; thence along said northerly boundary line of said Section 32 east 5.33 chains to the point of beginning, containing 74 acres, more or less. ALSO, beginning at the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M. thence west 613 feet; thence north 400 feet; thence northeasterly to a point on east line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 842 feet south of the south line of Orchard Street; thence south to beginning.

That the place of use has been changed to the following described land:

Beginning at a point 247.50 feet east of the southwest corner of Block 6 of Spring Grove Addition No. 1 to the City of Walla Walla, as per plat thereof recorded in Volume B of Plats at page 48, records of Walla Walla County, and running thence east along the south line of said Block 6, a distance of 147.50 feet; thence north 257.00 feet, more or less, to the center of the channel of the West Fork of Stone Creek; thence southwesterly and south along the center line of said West Fork of Stone Creek to the point of beginning.
