NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE OF PLACE OF USE OF WATER

TAKE NOTICE: That Frank Curcio of Walla Walla, Washington, has filed a petition for a permit to change the place of use of the waters of Upper Stone Creek in the amount of 0.012 cubic feet per second of water from April 1 to November 1 each year; being a portion of the amount granted in Certificate No. 5, Cause No. 15047, State of Washington v. Carmino Alessio, et al., That such water is being used for the purpose of irrigation on the following described land:

All that portion of Sec. 32, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M., described as commencing at a point 83 links south of the established corner for Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 of said township and range and running thence south 10.71 chains; thence north 86°30' east 11.65 chains; thence north 30° west 11.10 chains; thence west 6.80 chains to the place of beginning.

That he wishes to change the place of use of said waters to the following described lands:

Beginning at a point in a line parallel to and 30 feet east of the westerly line of Sec. 32, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M., which point is 479.2 feet south, measured along said parallel line from the north line of said Sec. 32, and running thence south along said parallel line a distance of 100 feet; then north 86°30' east 483.02 feet; thence north 8°15' west 101.05 feet; thence south 86°30' west 466.49 feet more or less to the point of beginning; Sec. 32, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.W.M. Walla Walla County Washington.

Any objections must be filed with the State Supervisor of the
Division of Water Resources within thirty (30) days from (last date
of publication).

PETITION FOR CHANGE OF PLACE OF USE OF WATER

TO THE STATE SUPERVISOR OF WATER RESOURCES OF WASHINGTON:

The undersigned, your petitioner, respectfully represents:

First: That he is a user of waters of Upper Stone Creek under Certificate No. 5, decreed right, State of Washington, plaintiff, vs. Carmino Alessio, et al, defendants, Court Decree Cause No. 15409, Upper Stone Creek Adjudication or appropriation made by claimant, Joseph Edward Painter, 9 acres of water in class No. 1, date 1863, by virtue of said cause No. 15409, Upper Stone Creek Adjudication.

Second: That such right consists of 0.119 cubic feet of water per second, April 1 to November 1 each year; that he wishes to change the place of use of water to the extent of 0.012 cubic feet of water per second, April 1 to November 1 each year.

Third: That such water is being used for the purpose of irrigation on the following described land (which description is erroneous):

The following described real property situated in Walla Walla County, Washington, to-wit: All that portion of Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 36, E.W.M. described as commencing at a point 83 links South of the established corner for Section 29, 30, 31 and 32 of said township and range and running thence South 10.71 chains; thence north 86 d. 30' east 11.65 chains; thence north 30 d. West 11.10 chains; thence West 6.80 chains to the place of beginning; containing 9.69 acres.

The correct land description is as follows:

Beginning at a point in the West line of Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 36, E.W.M., which point is 54.78 feet South measured along said West line, from the Northwest corner of said Section 32, thence South along said West line of said Section 32, a distance of 706.86 feet; thence North 86° 30' East, 833.8 feet more or less to the Westerly right-of-way line of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company; thence north-westerly along said Westerly line of said right-of-way

to its point of intersection with a line drawn parallel to and 54.78 feet South of the North line of said Section 32; thence West 448.8 feet more or less to point of beginning; EXCEPTING therefrom a 30 foot strip of land on the West portion of said described tract used for county road;

located in Section 32, Township 7, North Range 36, E.W.M.

Fourth: That he wishes to change the use of said waters for purpose of irrigation on the following described lands:

Beginning at a point in a line parallel to and 30 feet east of the westerly line of Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 36, which point is 479.2 feet South, measured along said parallel line from the North line of said Section 32, and running thence South along said parallel line a distance of 100 feet; then North $86^{\circ} 30'$ East 483.02 feet; thence North $8^{\circ} 15'$ West 101.05 feet; thence South $86^{\circ} 30'$ West 468.49 feet more or less to the point of beginning;

Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 36, E.W.M., Walla Walla County, Washington, and that such change can be made without detriment or injury to existing rights or the State's interest in water, as provided in Section 39, Chapter 117, Laws of 1917.
