

CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION
AND PLACE OF USE OF WATER

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto and rules thereunder, of the State Director of Water Resources.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That Frank and Wanda Cook of Wenatchee, Washington, have complied with all of the requirements of the Revised Code of Washington 90.03.380 and are hereby granted the right to change the point of diversion and place of use of waters of Squilchuck Creek, in the amount of 0.02 cubic foot per second, being a portion of the amount of 4.52 c.f.s. as granted under Certificate No. 1, decreed right, State of Washington vs. Millerdale Irrigation District, Cause No. 7647.

That the use of such water is for the purpose of irrigation and water was diverted from said stream at a point situated within SW¹/₄ of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 20 East W.M.

That they have changed said point of diversion to a point situated in the NE¹/₄ of Sec. 33, T. 22 N., R. 20 E.W.M., such point being approximately 550 feet south and 840 feet west from the northeast corner of Sec. 3.

That the water has been used for irrigation on lands within the Millerdale Irrigation District as described in the Decree under Cause No. 7647, dated June 14, 1928, of the Superior Court of Chelan County.

That the place of use of said waters has been changed to the following described lands:

Commencing at northeast corner of Sec. 33, T. 22 N., R. 20 E.W.M.; thence west along north line of said section 427 feet to Point A, on the westerly line of county road as existed in 1923; thence continue west on north line 709 feet; thence south 333 feet; thence southeasterly to a point which is true point of beginning, in the west line of said county road as existed in 1923, and which point is 586 feet, measured along said road, from Point A; thence northwesterly away from county road, along the last described course 280 feet, which course is the northeasterly boundary of property herein described; thence southwesterly parallel to county road 200 feet; thence southeasterly parallel to northeasterly boundary of property herein described 280 feet to west boundary of county road as existed in 1923; thence northerly along said west boundary 200 feet to point of beginning; EXCEPT road, Chelan County, Washington.

This right to change the point of diversion and place of use of waters, as indicated above, is subject to the following provision:

This change is issued subject to all provisions of the Squillichuck Creek Adjudication (Cause No. 7647, Chelan County Superior Court) and specifically the determination as to the duty of water for irrigation purposes of 1 miners inch (9 g.p.m.) per acre. Rate of diversion under this change shall not exceed subject duty of water.
