

**CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION
AND PLACE OF USE OF WATER**

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto and rules thereunder, of the State Director of Water Resources.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That Raymond A. Meuret of Wenatchee, Washington, has complied with all of the requirements of the Revised Code of Washington 90.03.380 and is hereby granted the right to change the point of diversion and place of use of waters of Squillichuck Creek, in the amount of 0.02 cubic foot per second, being a portion of the amount of 4.52 c.f.s. as granted under Certificate No. 1, decreed right, State of Washington vs. Millersdale Irrigation District, Cause No. 7647.

That the use of such water is for the purpose of irrigation and water was diverted from said stream at a point situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 20 East W.M.

That he has changed said point of diversion to a point situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 21 N., R. 20 E.W.M., such point being approximately 850 feet north and 860 feet west of center of Sec. 8.


That the water has been used for irrigation on lands within the Millersdale Irrigation District as described in the Decree under Cause No. 7647, dated June 14, 1928, of the Superior Court of Chelan County.

That the place of use of said waters has been changed to the following described lands:

Commence at the southwest corner of E $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 21 N., R. 20 E.W.M.; thence east along the south line thereof for 396 feet; thence north 1452 feet; thence east 660 feet; thence south 198 feet to a point on Squillichuck Creek and the true point of beginning; thence continuing south 75 feet; thence southwesterly to a point on the county road as it exists on February 2, 1965, which point is 75 feet southerly of the intersection of the county road and Squillichuck Creek; thence northerly 75 feet along the county road to Squillichuck Creek; thence northeasterly along Squillichuck Creek to the true point of beginning, Chelan County, Washington.
