PROVISIONS

All conditions and requirements contained in reports of examination or permits previously issued apply to this certificate unless specifically noted below.

An approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", Chapter 173-173 WAC.

Water use data shall be recorded annually and maintained by the property owner for a minimum of five years, and shall be promptly submitted to Ecology upon request.

The following information shall be included with each submittal of water use data: owner, contact name if different, mailing address, daytime phone number, WRIA, Permit/Certificate/Claim No., source name, annual quantity used including units, maximum rate of diversion including units.


1. monthly meter readings including units,
2. fish screen status, and period of use. In the future, Ecology may require additional parameters to be reported or more frequent reporting. Ecology prefers web based data entry, but does accept hard copies. Ecology will provide forms and electronic data entry information.




This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for non-use of water as provided in Chapter 90.14 RCW.

conveyed to E. Herbert Turner and wife by Deed dated March 23, 1961 and recorded under file number 640000. TOGETHER WITH and subject to an easement for ingress, egress and utilities over, under and across a strip of land 20 feet in width, the Northerly line of which is the Southerly line of the herein above described property extended South 76°22' East to the Westerly margin of county road known as Woodard Bay Road. That part of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 24, T. 19 N., R. 2 W.W.M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of said subdivision 539.41 feet North of its Southwest corner; running thence South 76°22' East 496 feet to the True Point of Beginning; thence continuing South 76°22' East 150 feet; thence South 22°32' West 112 feet; thence North 76°22' West 150 feet; thence North 22°32' East 112 feet to the point of beginning. TOGETHER WITH an easement for ingress, egress and utilities over, under and across a strip of land 20 feet in width, the Northerly line of which is the Northeasterly line of the herein above described property, extended South 76°22' East to the Westerly margin of county road known as Woodard Bay Road.

Provisions Continued

Chapter 173-173 WAC describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements. Installation, operation and maintenance requirements are enclosed as a document entitled "Water Measurement Device Installation and Operation Requirements".

Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, shall have access at reasonable times, to the records of water use that are kept to meet the above conditions, and to inspect at reasonable times any measuring device used to meet the above conditions.
