6. DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM PROPOSED OR INSTALLED

(FOR EXAMPLE: SIZE OF PUMP, CAPACITY OF PUMP, PUMP MOTOR HORSE POWER, PIPE DIAMETER, NUMBER OF SPRINKLERS, ETC.)

The 117 acres of Kyle Mathison will be pumped into a 100+ acre feet resevoir during times of low water damand when the irrigation district would have normally shut off its pumps.

The other 400 G.P.M. would need additional pumps as needed when demand dictates.

1st Stage: 30 h.p. pump at the river; with 2,000 feet of 22" pipe, 124' elevation

2nd Stage: 100 h.p. pump; with 5,050' of 16" pipe, 576' elevation.

3rd Stage: 100 h.p. pump; with 8,050' of 12" pipe, 720" elevation.

The acres of Bryant and Kyle Mathison will be irrigated with microsprinklers at 200 heads/acre at .3 G.P.M./Head. Bob & Tom Mathison acres will be rainbird sprinklers 7/64 nozzel at 2 G.P.M./Head and 40 heads/Acre.

I understand that if a temporary permit is issued, there is no guarantee 1) that a permanent water right will be issued after its expiration, or 2) that more stringent conditions will not be included if a permanent water right is issued. I further understand that a temporary permit will not be considered for issuance immediately. Existing applications on file which are not subject to the moratorium, and temporary permit requests which were received prior to my request, will be evaluated first.

Option 3. I prefer to withdraw my application from further consideration at this time. I understand that I may reapply at a later date.
