This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate public water from \_\_\_\_\_ located in \_\_\_\_\_ Smith Spring and to inform you of your options for further processing of the application. Until July 1, 1989, the Department of Ecology is prohibited by law from issuing normal water right permits that will appropriate surface water.

This prohibition is found in Second Substitute Senate Bill 6724 passed by the 1988 legislature. This law states in part "the Department of Ecology...for any new application for surface water received after the effective date of this act (March 15, 1988), shall not issue any permanent appropriation permits...." The purpose of this moratorium is to withhold further issuance of permanent appropriations of surface water pending completing of a legislative review of the state's water resource allocation laws and programs.

Your application and fee are enclosed to allow you to determine what should now be done with your application. Your options regarding further disposition of your application are as follows:

Option 1

If you would like us to accept and hold your application until after the end of the moratorium, return it and the fee by \_\_\_\_\_ to this office. It must be accompanied by the enclosed ~~form~~ <sup>9-20-88</sup> with your signature indicating your preference. If you so choose, your application will be held on file until July 1, 1989 or until the legislature has provided further direction to the department, whichever comes first.

If the application, fee and response form are received by this office on or before \_\_\_\_\_, your application will retain its original priority ~~date~~ <sup>9-20-88</sup> (the date of original receipt in this office) that is indicated by the date stamp on the application form. If your application is received after \_\_\_\_\_, your original priority date will be forfeited and a new ~~priority date~~ <sup>9-20-89</sup> will be assigned according to the date it is received by this office.

Option 2

If you prefer that your application be considered for issuance of a temporary permit, return the application and fee by 9-20-88 to retain the priority date indicated by the date stamp on the application form. It must be accompanied by the enclosed form with your signature indicating your preference. If the application is received after 9-20-88, your original priority date will be forfeited and a new priority date will be assigned.

If a temporary permit is granted, you will be authorized to construct your system for appropriating water and to put water to beneficial use only until midnight June 30, 1989. Following that date, Ecology will determine whether and under what conditions a normal water right permit may be issued. Issuance of a temporary permit is no guarantee that you will be permitted to appropriate water after June 30, 1989. Legislative action may follow the period of legislative review that could substantially affect whether and under what conditions a permanent water right could be issued. You should carefully consider this risk before requesting a temporary permit and investing in your proposed water system.


Option 3

You may elect to do nothing further at this time, in which case your priority date will be forfeited after 9-20-88. If this is your preference, you may return the response form so indicating, but it is not necessary to do so. You may reapply at a later date and acquire a new priority date at that time.

PLEASE NOTE: To retain the priority date of your application, you must return it, the fee, and the enclosed form indicating your choice and bearing your signature.
