





For both the pump site location and the irrigated ground.

Heading south on 395 between Kennewick and Umatilla, take exit 122 Coffin Road. Continue on Coffin Road for 5 miles and take a left on Nine canyon road. Follow nine canyon road for 3.5 miles and take a right on Kirk road. Follow Kirk road for 3.5 miles and take a right on Finley road, heading south.

For Pump site, Continue on Finley road and keep going after road ends. Road ends at Easterday farms. Follow same road going south and follow private road called Easterday farms road #6. Road #6 forks, take the left that goes down to the river down a canyon. This will lead to the pump site, located adjacent to the railroad tracks.

For Ground To Be Irrigated, continue on finley road until you see private road called Easterday farms road # 4, located on right hand side. Follow this road for 1 mile going around irrigated circles, and then take a left when road ends. Then take the first farm road on your right for 1/3 of a mile, and the road runs along the section boundary for the DNR section, 16.




