



I understand that if a temporary permit is issued, there is no guarantee 1) that a permanent water right will be issued after its expiration, or 2) that more stringent conditions will not be included if a permanent water right is issued. I further understand that a temporary permit will not be considered for issuance immediately. Existing applications on file which are not subject to the moratorium, and temporary permit requests which were received prior to my request, will be evaluated first.

Option 3. I prefer to withdraw my application from further consideration at this time. I understand that I may reapply at a later date.

If options 1 or 2 are selected, return this form with your signature, the application and application fee to the Department of Ecology.

If option 3 is selected, you may return this form only to the Department of Ecology, but it is not necessary.

If you do not respond within the time allowed in the accompanying letter, Ecology will assume you are no longer interested in pursuing the application and your priority date will be forfeited.
