All that portion of Government Lot 7, Section 1, Township 29 North, Range 23 East, W.M., lying Westerly of the Westerly right of way line of the Burlington Northern Railway;

EXCEPTING that part lying West of State Highway.

All that portion of Government Lot 9, Section 1, Township 29 North, Range 23 East, W.M., lying Westerly of the Westerly right of way line of the Burlington Northern Railway and Easterly of the State Highway right of way, less County Road.

All that portion of Government Lot 3, Section 1, Township 29 North, Range 23 East, W.M., lying Westerly of the right of way line of the Burlington Northern Railway and Northeasterly of Okanogan County Road No. 1525 Northerly right of way line;




