



From Yakima take I-82 E to Kennewick exit Hwy 395 N, then Hwy 397 S (Chemical Drive) to Finley. Turn right onto Piert Road, Left onto Meals Road, Left onto Ayers Road. After 1/4 mile turn left onto a jeep trail leading to the well site.




