

Provisions

All applicable conditions and requirements contained in reports of examination or permits previously issued apply to this certificate unless specifically noted below.

“Allocation of waters among potential uses and users shall be based generally on the securing of the maximum net benefits for the people of the state. Maximum net benefits shall constitute total benefits less costs, including opportunities lost.”

“Certificate holder shall contact the Department of Game and, in conjunction with that agency, develop a wildlife conservation and management plan. Such plan shall include evaluation of existing conditions, planned preservation and/or enhancement of wildlife and/or wildlife habitat, on the nonfarmed area and provisions for management of existing or new wildlife habitat areas. Said plan shall be submitted to the Department within six (6) months from the date of permit issuance for review and approval; said plan to provide for a reasonable regulated use of his nonfarmed lands for the public benefit. There will not be a required financial commitment beyond a one time nominal expense, nor will special farming practices be expected of the permit holder.”

“The entire opening of the diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than 0.14 inch. Water approach velocity to the screen shall be less than 1 foot per second and approaching 0.5 foot per second, as measured one (1) foot in front of the screen.”

“The division of Superseding Certificate No. S4-23978C(A) issued on July 8, 1987 into Superseding Certificate No. S4-23978C(A) and Certificate No. S4-23978C(C) issued in August 2003 shall not be construed as validation as to the extent of Superseding Certificate No. S4-23978C(C). The amounts provided on Superseding Certificate No. S4-23978C(C) reflect agreement among the owners of the original described place of use, but are not confirmed by Ecology in this recording of the division of said right. The actual amounts authorized by Superseding Certificate No. S4-23978C(C) are subject to historic beneficial use.”
