The following portions of Section 22, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter; EXCEPT the North 300 feet thereof; and EXCEPT a tract described as follows: From the Southern most corner of Block 73 of the Town of Bridgeport as per plat recorded in Volume A of Town Plats, at page 66, records of the County of Douglas; run North along the West boundary of Blocks 73 and 72 and beyond a total distance of 572.81 feet to the point of beginning of this tract; thence run North 45° West 200 feet; thence run North 45° East 200 feet, more or less, to a point in the West boundary of Block 53 of said plat; thence run South along said boundary to the point of beginning of description of this excepted portion.

The Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter, the South half of the Northwest quarter, the Southwest quarter, EXCEPT the West half of the West half thereof.

The Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and those portions of the North half of the Southeast quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and Blocks 74, 108 and 120 (and vacated streets adjoining the same) of said Town of Bridgeport, lying South and West of a line drawn as follows:


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

SUBJECT: Legal Description for Water Right Applications
File Nos.: S4-32207, S4-32208, G4-32209,
S4-32210, S4-32211, S4-32212, and S4-32213.

The above applications all share the same legal description for the requested place of use. In attempting to draw out the legal description on a map, we find that more information is needed. The description refers to other plats which we do not have and so their location is unknown to us.

I have enclosed a copy of the legal description with the problem areas underlined. Would you please provide us with legal descriptions which we can map for these areas? An alternative would be for you to take the legal description to a law office or surveyor familiar with such descriptions and have them do the necessary research and mapping. The map and supporting documents could then be forwarded to our office for the files. The map scale should be no smaller than 1:24000, which is the scale of United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7½ minute quadrangle maps.

In the area where you have applied, we are digitizing and storing water right applications in our computer. This is why it is important for the legal description to be clarified early in the application process.
