We propose to use 3 wells (2 drilled, 1 not started) to supply domestic and irrigation water for the I-90 Eastbound and I-90 Westbound Indian John Hill Rest Areas (Approx. M.P. 89.1). Each well being 8" in diameter and having a 10 h.p. pump and connected to a 1,000 gallon pressure tank in the Westbound Rest Area. Distribution of water will be through existing pipes. We do not anticipate storing water.

In preparing this application, I included the existing 15.3 Acre-feet of water rights and 3.0 Acre-feet of supplemental water rights (total water rights of 18.3 Acre-feet) in the 80 Acre-feet being requested. The 30 Acre-feet is 61.7 Acre-feet over and above the water rights granted by permits 8407 and 7623, attached.
