

From Goldendale get on Hwy. 14 heading east toward Roosevelt. Take a left on the Roosevelt Grade Rd. Go up the hill passing the Roosevelt Regional Landfill signs. The road you are on will eventually become the East Rd. as you make a sharp bend to the right. Follow this until you see Six Prong. Take that right hand turn. Continue on this road passing the Roosevelt Gas Plant. You now have five more miles to go. Take a left on Six Prong Extension. We are further down this road on the right hand side. You'll see our log structure building.

From Yakima head toward Sunnyside. Take Exit # 67, (Sunnyside/Mabton). Take a right at the end of the off ramp. Take a left at next Mabton Sign. Then a right at the flashing red light which is a four way stop. Continue heading toward Mabton. Take a left on Jct. 22. Take a right on Main St. in Mabton which will soon become the Glade Rd. Continue until you see a sign for the Alderdale Rd. Take a left on Alderdale Rd. Continue for quite a few miles (we are 35 mi. from Mabton) until you see Peterson Rd. Take a right. This is the beginning of the 11 miles of graveled roads. When you see a cattle camp on your right take a left on the Sand Ridge Rd. At the Y in the road you will want to vere to the right. This will be the Hale Rd. Follow this until you See Six Prong Extension. Take a left. We are one mile down on the left hand side.
