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# Certificate Of Adjudicated Water Right

THIS IS TO CERTIFY:

That by virtue of a decree of the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for Chelan County, made and entered on the 10th day of May 1985 in the case of State of Washington v. Thomas A. Anderson, et ux, et al., County Cause No. 36078, which decree determined the rights of all known claimants to the use of the waters of Nahahum Canyon Drainage Basin, in accordance with Chapters 90.03 and 90.44 Revised Code of Washington.

is entitled to use, subject to provisions set forth in said decree, and the laws of the State of Washington, the waters of a well (dug).

The water right is confirmed in the amount of water that is reasonably and actually necessary for the purpose of domestic supply for two homes and shall not exceed 10 gpm; 2 acre-feet per year, continuously for domestic supply. The 10 gpm withdrawal rate is a duplicate of, and not an addition to those amounts awarded in the confirmation of the Class XIII June 30, 1943, and Class XVI June 30, 1960 rights from this well.

That the decree aforesaid establishes said right in Class XXI, with a priority date of June 30, 1977.

That the approximate point(s) of withdrawal are as follows:

1650 feet north and 125 feet west of the southeast corner  
Section 22, being within the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 22, T. 24 N.,  
R. 19 E.W.M.

That said water right was adjudged by said decree to be and is appurtenant to the following described real property situated in Chelan County, Washington, to-wit:

NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 27, NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  and SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 22, all being within T. 24 N., R. 19 E.W.M.

Any changes in these rights can only be in compliance with Chapters 90.03 and 90.44 RCW.

This certificate of adjudicated water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in Chapter 90.14 RCW.

This instrument is recorded in the office of the Department of Ecology, Olympia, Washington, in Volume XIV-D, of Adjudicated Water Right Certificates, at Page 34.
