B. Briefly describe your proposed water system. (See instructions.)

Columbia View Water Services is an existing water system and consists of three wells currently producing domestic and irrigation services to approximately 119 connections located in the Columbia View district. Well #1 and Well #2 are connected to 76,400 gallon above ground storage tank. Well #3 is connected to the east side of the distribution system. The water goes from the tank to the distribution system through a booster pump station. The pump station has four pumps: 5 HP, 10 HP, 15 HP, and 25 HP. The purpose is to supply water in the distribution system at about 60 PSI at all times. Well #3 is used to supplement the east side of the system during summer months to help maintain pressure. Existing land use in the service area is all platted and planned residential. The area adjacent to Columbia View is also platted residential and farm land (adjacent to the SE) of Columbia View.

No future land use changes are being considered at this, and no future expansion is anticipated.
