

6. DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM PROPOSED OR INSTALLED

I intend to use one portable 5hp pump rated at 200gpm to pump from the lake to a staging cistern of 250 gallons. Then in order to lift the water up the additional 500+ ft to the homesite, a second positive displacement pump of 60gpm will be driven off a gas power plant (2 liter car engine) and the water will be placed into a 1200 gallon cistern for domestic use. Pipe diameter will be 1 1/4 inches. Water will be treated at the cistern. Check valves will be used.

REMARKS

7. This will be our only source of water since the terrain is too steep and remote for a drill rig. All pipes and pumps will be camouflaged and unobtrusive to meet the conditions set forth in Appendix 2-Water Withdrawal Systems of the Special Park Use Management Plan -




