TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that City of Davenport, of Davenport, Washington, under date of June 1, 1948, filed with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, Olympia, Washington, a declaration of claim of vested right existing prior to June 7, 1945, to withdraw public ground waters from a pump well situated in Davenport locality in the amount of 500 gallons per minute; 800 acre-feet per year, with priority (date of first beneficial use of water) of the year 1913, which water is used continuously each year for the purpose of industrial and municipal supply that the location of the well from which water is withdrawn is within Lot 10, Block 5 of Dillon's Addition to the City of Davenport (Sec. 21, Twp. 25 N., Rge. 37 E.W.-M.) county of Lincoln, and has requested a Certificate of Water Right under such claim.

Any person, firm or corporation disputing such claim or protesting that the right claimed is not a vested right to be recognized under Chap. 263 of the 1945 Session Laws of the State of Washington, may file with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, at Olympia, Washington, such objections or representations, in writing, as he may desire to make, within thirty (30) days after date of last publication, which date is July 15, 1948.
