

- a) Spring - 550 feet South and 1000 feet West of the center of Section 18.
- b) Lake - 1100 feet South and 1000 feet West of the center of Section 18.

CONTINUED LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

Lot 15 of Crescent Lakeside Tracts being a subdivision of lots 3, 4, 5, 6 and according to plat thereof recorded in Vol. 4 Page 12 of Plats. Also Shorelands in front of Lot 15 of Crescent Lakeside Tracts situate in Clallam County, State of Washington.

PROVISIONS

"Use of water under this permit/certificate shall be limited to in-house domestic supply."

"Diversions from the lake and the spring source shall not exceed a cumulative total of .02 cfs and 0.34 acre-feet per year. The diversion from the spring shall only be used when the lake is not capable of supplying the desired quantity and quality of water."

An approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", Chapter 173-173 WAC.

Water use data shall be recorded annually and maintained by the property owner for a minimum of five years, and shall be promptly submitted to Ecology upon request.


Chapter 173-173 WAC describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and

information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements. Installation, operation and maintenance requirements are enclosed as a document entitled "Water Measurement Device Installation and Operation Requirements".

The intake shall be screened at all times in accordance with Department of Fish and Wildlife screening criteria. This water right is issued subject to Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Hydraulic Project Approval.
