If yes, explain why you are unable to connect to the system: Our community well was drilled in 1960 for 10 lots which have since been subdivided into 12 lots. Currently, 7 lots are developed and serviced by the well. Of the remaining lots, one parcel is owned by BWUA and is designated open space, 2 have been developed and serviced by separately drilled wells, and two parcels remain undeveloped. The members whose parcels are serviced by other wells would like to connect to Bonzai's well because it has a lower iron content. The members whose parcels are undeveloped would like to have access to water so their properties can be developed. The water system is currently designated as non-expanding beyond the present seven connections by Thurston County.
