NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF CLAIM OF RIGHT TO WITHDRAW GROUND WATER NO. 871 State of Washington Office of Supervisor of Hydraulics Olympia

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that Leo J. Mangan of Wallula, Washington, under date of May 29, 1948, filed with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, Olympia, Washington, a declaration of claim of vested right existing prior to June 7, 1948, to withdraw public ground waters from a pump well situated in Wallula locality in the amount of 150 gallons per minute; 158 acre-feet per year, with priority (date of first beneficial use of water) of March 1, 1923, which water is used during irrigation season each year for the purpose of irrigation; and continuously for domestic supply; that the location of the well from which water is withdrawn is within Lot 12, Block 1 of Chamberlains Addition to Wallula, county of Walla Walla, and has requested a Certificate of Water Right under such claim.

Any person, firm or corporation disputing such claim or protesting that the right claimed is not a vested right to be recognized under Chap. 263 of the 1945 Session Laws of the State of Washington, may file with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, at Olympia, Washington, such objections or representations, in writing, as he may desire to make, within thirty (30) days after date of last publication, which date is June 22, 1948.
