NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF CLAIM OF RIGHT TO WITHDRAW GROUND WATER NO. 411.
 State of Washington, Office of Supervisor of Hydraulics, Olympia, Wash.
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
 Notice is hereby given that Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company of Portland, State of Oregon, under date of April 19, 1947, filed with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, Olympia, Washington, a declaration of claim of vested right existing prior to June 7, 1945, to withdraw public ground waters from an artesian well in Olympia locality in the amount of 7 gallons per minute; 11.3 acre-feet per year, with priority (date of first beneficial use of water) of the year 1915, which water is used continuously each year for the purpose of locomotive supply; that the location of the artesian well from which water is withdrawn is within Lot 7, Block 44 of Sylvester's Addition to the City of Olympia (NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 14, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W. W. M.) county of Thurston, and has requested a Certificate of Water Right under such claim.
 Any person, firm or corporation disputing such claim or protesting that the right claimed is not a vested right to be recognized under Chap. 263 of the 1945 Session Laws of the State of Washington, may file with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, at Olympia, Washington, such objections or representations, in writing, as he may desire to make, within thirty (30) days after date of last publication, which date is May 7.
