



NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF CLAIM
OF RIGHT TO WITHDRAW GROUND
WATER NO. 432
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
Notice is hereby given that Butler's
Cove Water Company, of Olympia, State of
Washington, under date of May 20, 1947,
filed with the State Supervisor of Hy-
draulics, Olympia, Washington, a declara-
tion of claim of vested right existing prior
to June 7, 1945, to withdraw public ground
waters from a pump and flowing well in
Olympia locality in the amount of 25
gallons per minute; 45 acre-feet per year,
with priority (date of first beneficial use
of water) of the year 1925, which water
is used continuously each year for the
purpose of domestic supply for a com-
munity; that the location of the pump
well from which water is withdrawn is
within Lot 17, Olympia Golf and Country
Club plat unrecorded (Government Lot 4,
Sec. 33, Twp. 19 N., Rgs. 2 W. W. M.)
county of Thurston, and has requested a
Certificate of Water Right under such
claim.
Any person, firm or corporation dis-
puting such claim or protesting that the
right claimed is not a vested right to be
recognized under Chap. 263 of the 1945
Session Laws of the State of Washing-
ton, may file with the State Supervisor of
Hydraulics, at Olympia, Washington, such
objections or representations, in writing,
as he may desire to make, within thirty
(30) days after date of last publication,
which date is June 17, 1947.
