We are pleased to let you know that your extension request on the above-referenced permit has been granted. Your new deadline to put the water to full beneficial use and submit a completed Proof of Appropriation form is **June 1, 2010**.

When you return the completed Proof of Appropriation form to us, be sure that:

- It is **notarized**.
- You have written in the **parcel number** for the point of diversion/withdrawal for where your project is located (and the place of use, if different). Parcel numbers can be found on property tax statements or obtained through the assessor's office.

Upon receipt of your Proof of Appropriation form, we will review the information and may come out to inspect your project. Once we are confident that all of the terms and provisions of your permit have been met, we will notify you by mail to request the certificate recording fees for the state and county.

You have the right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board. Pursuant to chapter 43.21B RCW, your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, and served on the Department of Ecology, within thirty (30) days of the date of your receipt of this document. To appeal this action or decision, your notice of appeal must contain a copy of the Ecology order, action or decision you are appealing.



If you do not expect to have the water put to full beneficial use by **June 1, 2005**; you should request further extensions, as needed. To request additional extensions, you will need to submit a letter explaining why an extension is needed, including how many more connections are proposed on this water system. You may extend for more than one year at a time at a rate of \$5.00 per year.

This order may be appealed. 
