**Memo to File G2-28161
Firgrove Mutual Water
Jill Walsh - SWRO**

In 1993, the relinquishment of two water right certificates - 2190-A and G2-26739, was made a provision of Firgrove's permit G2-28161. However, when the annual quantities for permit G2-28161 were calculated, we overlooked the fact that while the actual wells weren't needed, the relinquishment of previously issued primary water rights would leave Firgrove short of needed annual capacity.

I recommend that we amend this permit to re-issue the otherwise lost primary allocation. It amounts to 56 acre-feet per year. Firgrove has already relinquished the certificates.

Dear Roy;

As we discussed, I am sending you the DRAFT *Reports of Examination* on Firgrove's two pending applications. It is my intent to recommend that they both be approved - supplemental to existing rights, but be advised that my supervisor has not reviewed them yet, and the final decision is not mine to make!

I would appreciate it very much, if you could take a look at them, and let me know if you have any changes or questions. You will notice that I reference some of the provisions of your permit G2-28161 for Well 9. When the *Report of Examination* was written for that permit, Ecology requested the relinquishment of two old certificates associated with unused wells - because those rights were never actually relinquished, I made that a requirement of these pending permits. (Please note, that I readjusted the quantities associated with those rights to keep Firgrove acre-footage allocation the same.)

When permit G2-28161 is ready to proceed to final certificate, I will change the supplemental annual allocation to part primary. I'm also sending you a two relinquishment forms, so you can get that process underway.

Please feel free to call me at (360) 407-0274 if I've confused you! I'll be out of the office the last week of August, but back on September 2.



It is requested that a one year extension be granted for the indicated permit.

Contract administration on two new major water storage reservoirs has precluded Firgrove Mutual from being able to proceed with the development of the well project.

In checking your file, I find that you have not responded to our letter requesting fees for filing and recording your final certificate of water right.

If the water has been put to full use according to the terms of your permit, please send two separate remittances in the form of checks or money orders, cash will NOT be excepted:


\$5.00 payable to the Department of Ecology
AND
\$8.00 payable to the Pierce County Auditor

Send both remittances to the Department of Ecology. Your Certificate and Auditor Check will be forward to the Auditor's Office. By following the above instructions, you will receive your final water right certificate.

If more time is required to put the water to full use, you should request an extension of one year. By statute, a \$5.00 fee must accompany such a request, together with a showing of good cause why your extension should be granted and a report of progress made during the last year.

If we do not hear from you within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, we shall be forced to assume that you are no longer interested in retaining the permit, and action will be taken resulting in cancellation. You are also reminded that continued use of water after cancellation of your permit would be subject to regulation.
