Dear Mr. Blackman:

In reviewing your files, I noticed we have not received your Proof of Appropriation form. This letter is to remind you that the development schedule of your water right permit required that water be at beneficial use and the Proof of Appropriation form submitted by **December 1, 2006**.

There are a number of possible steps you may need to take in order to bring your permit back into good standing, depending on the status of your project. Please refer to the following chart:

If this is the case:	You need to do this within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter:
You have put the water to full beneficial use .	Complete and submit the Proof of Appropriation form. The form must be <u>notarized</u> , and include the parcel number for the point of withdrawal/diversion. Please include evidence that shows you have installed an approved measuring device, as well as data that you have collected on this permit.
You need more time to put the water to beneficial use.	1. Submit a written request for an extension (refer to enclosed fact sheet for instructions). 2. Submit extension fee (\$50.00).
You no longer intend to develop your project.	Notify Ecology's Southwest Regional office in writing.
You need more information.	Contact our office at (360) 407-6300.

Failure to respond to this letter within 30 days may result in the cancellation of your permit.

Dear Sir or Madame:

Re: Water Right Permit No. **G2-28386**

In compliance with your request, you are hereby granted an extension of time until **December 1, 2006**, to put the water to full beneficial use and file a notice of such action under the above mentioned permit.

Please submit the following when the actual water has been put to full beneficial use:

- ° Proof of Appropriation form filled out and notarized
- ° **\$21.00** check payable to the **Pierce County Auditor's Office**
- ° **\$5.00** check payable to the Department of Ecology

Please send both checks to the Department of Ecology and we will forward the Auditor check along with your Certificate to the County Auditor's Office for recording. **Also, the County Auditor is requiring that we have the parcel number for your property added to your Certificate. Please provide the parcel number for the point of withdrawal/diversion and the place of use.**

If you do not expect to have the water put to full beneficial use by **December 1, 2006**, you should request further extensions, as needed. To request additional extensions, you will need to submit a letter explaining why an extension is needed, including how many more connections are proposed on this water system. You may extend for more than one year at a time at a rate of \$5.00 per year.

Your right to appeal

You have the right to appeal this Report of Examination to the Pollution Control Hearings Board. Pursuant to chapter 43.21B RCW, your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, and served on the Department of Ecology, within thirty (30) days of the date of your receipt of this document. To appeal this action or decision, your notice of appeal must contain a copy of the Ecology order, action or decision you are appealing.



Dear Mr. Blackman:

Re: Water Permit No.G2-28386 (Rosedale Heights #3)

While checking the progress of your water rights, I noticed that you have not sent in the Proof of Appropriation Form.

If you are using the full amount of water shown on your permit, please fill out the enclosed Proof of Appropriation form, have it notarized, and return it to this office. The statutory recording fees are to be sent in as two separate remittances in the form of checks or money orders. Cash will NOT be accepted. Send both remittances to the Department of Ecology.

\$5.00 payable to the Department of Ecology
AND
\$21.00 payable to the Pierce County Auditor

Also, the County Auditor is requiring that we have the parcel number(s) for the point of withdrawal/diversion and the place of use if different. Please send those numbers to us with your recording fees.

By following the above instruction, your final water right will be prepared, sent to your County Auditor for recording, and then forwarded to you by your County Auditor.

In addition, one of the provisions of the permit is that a metering device be installed and that meter readings be recorded at **least monthly**. Please include meter readings for a least the past year with the completed Proof of Appropriation form.

If more time is required to put the water to full use, you should request an extension of time in writing. By statute, a **\$5.00 fee per year must accompany such a request, together with a showing of good cause why your extension should be granted and a report of progress made during the last year**. The Proof of Appropriation for your water right permit was due on, **December 1, 2004**, if an extension is needed, please send **\$5.00** payable to the Department of Ecology along with your request to extend your file until **December 1, 2005**.

If we do not hear from you within **thirty (30) days** from the date of this letter, we shall be forced to assume that you are no longer interested in retaining the permit, and action will be taken resulting in cancellation.



Once we are confident that all of terms and provisions of your permit have been met, we will notify by you mail to request the certificate recording fees for the state and county.

Read your permit

Please read through your entire permit, along with the enclosed water right information sheet, to be sure you fully understand the terms and responsibilities associated with your permit. It is important to remember that this permit is not a *final* water right, it is permission by the state to *develop* a water right. *You must meet the provisions on your permit before we issue your final water right certificate.*
