Attached is the \$ 20.00 statutory permit fee for ground water application No. G2-28697. To assure clarity we would like to summarize the Report of Examination.

Under the report of examination the following will apply:

1. Maximum withdrawal rate - 1,200 GPM, supplemental, non-additive to our existing, 3,000 GPM, Qi rate at well # 7, cert. # G2-20182
2. Maximum acre feet/year - 1,290, supplemental to our existing maximum Qa of 2,400 for well # 7, cert. # G2-20182.
3. The well will be completed in the sea-level aquifer. Due to the proposed well's location in relation to other Spanaway Water Company wells there is a fair degree of certainty of the existence and confined nature of the sea-level aquifer at the proposed well site.

If this summary is not accurate please contact me as soon as possible. Also enclosed is an original copy of the Affidavit of Publication for this proposed well.

Additionally, enclosed are applications for change for wells S1 and S2, certificate No.'s G2-26091C and G2-26991C respectively. The changes requested for both wells are for "use" to "municipal purpose"; the "Place of Use" to the area served by the Water Cooperative of Pierce County, and time of use to "Continuous" for G2-26991C. Please forward the public notice for publication to our office. The affidavits of publication will be sent to your office when we receive them.




