Dear Mr. Blackman:

We received your **December 15, 2006** request for a Proof of Appropriation extension on the above-referenced water permit.

By statute (RCW 90.03.320), projects under permit must be pursued with due diligence and be completed in a reasonable period. Please provide the following information, so that I may better evaluate your extension request.

- A description of efforts made since the last extension was granted in 2004.
- A proposed schedule for completing the development.
- Evidence that shows you have installed an approved water-measuring device, as well as any relevant metering data.
- An anticipated time schedule for completing construction and completing development of the water system, accompanied by explanation as to how any identified impediments to meeting the current development schedule will be overcome.

Submit this information in letter format to the Department of Ecology as soon as possible. **Failure to respond to this letter within 30 days may result in the cancellation of your permit.**

In reviewing your file, I noticed we have not received your Proof of Appropriation form. A previous reminder letter was sent on **August 30, 2005**, to which there was no response. This letter is to remind you that the development schedule of your water right permit required that water be put to beneficial use and the Proof of Appropriation form be submitted as soon as possible.

There are a number of possible steps you may need to take in order to bring your permit back into good standing, depending on the status of your project. Please refer to the following chart:

**If we do not hear from you within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter, your permit will be in jeopardy of cancellation without further notice.**



Once we are confident that all of terms and provisions of your permit have been met, we will notify by you mail to request the certificate recording fees for the state and county.

***Read your permit***

Please read through your entire permit, along with the enclosed water right information sheet, to be sure you fully understand the terms and responsibilities associated with your permit. It is important to remember that this permit is not a *final* water right, it is permission by the state to *develop* a water right. *You must meet the provisions on your permit before we issue your final water right certificate.*
