Dir Sir,

As you requested during our phone conversation today, I am attaching the two water right permits that you requested to see. It appears to me that they are not connected. I will try to provide some detail below:

S2-29856 -

This permit is for a maximum withdrawal of 2,800 acre feet per year. It is an additive permit to S2195, S2-01119C, G2-24762C, and S2-29856. The total of all of these permits cannot exceed 5,600 acre feet per year. The source of this water is the Cowlitz River, with the proposed water works being the "existing Ranney collector" on the river.

This permit was to reach full beneficial use, or 2,800 acre feet per year by December 1, 2005. It also should have a meter installed, with meter readings recorded monthly. If you still need to install a meter, we can grant you an extension so that you may collect this information.

G2-29813 -

This permit is for three wells. You can note their exact location on your water right permit. The permit is issued for a total of 2400 acre feet per year, with 1128 acre feet per year as Primary and 1272 as Supplemental.

Under the provisions it is stated, " The total amount of water diverted under certificates or permits S2195, S2-01119C, G2-24762C, S2-29856, G2-29813, and G2-29815 shall be limited to 6728 acre feet per year."

A Completion of Construction form does not need to be submitted for this permit until December 1, 2008.



Your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, PO Box 40903, Olympia, WA 98504-0903 within thirty (30) days of the date this Order was mailed by the Department of Ecology. At the same time a copy of your appeal must be sent to the Department of Ecology, c/o Water Resources Appeal Coordinator, PO Box 47600, Olympia, WA 98504-7600. Your appeal alone will not stay the effectiveness of this order. Stay requests must be submitted in accordance with RCW 43.21B.320. These procedures are consistent with Chapter 43.21B RCW.

Re: Water Permit No's. G2-29813, G2-29815 (new wells), and S2-29856 (Ranney collector)

Thank you for calling regarding the City of Kelso permit number G2-29815. After reviewing the Report of Examination for this permit, I realized there were two other permits that were issued at the same time, G2-29813 and S2-29856. The above referenced permits are currently in the Completion of Construction stage of development. The development schedule for all three permits require that construction be completed on the water system on or before **December 1, 2003**, and that you notify this office that construction has been completed by submitting the enclosed Completion of Construction reports (one for each project).

If construction of the wells and Ranney collector project are not completed by December 1, 2003, you may request an extension of time. Since state law requires that projects be pursued with diligence and that good cause be shown before an extension can be granted, your extension request must be made in writing and contain the following:

1. A description of efforts you have made to complete construction on the projects since the permits were issued or the last extensions were granted.
2. A time schedule for completing the projects and developing the system.
3. Reason(s) for needing the extension.
4. Any additional remarks concerning your projects that will assist us in making our decision of whether to grant the extension.
5. Check or money order for the **\$5.00** extension fee for each project (\$15.00 total) made payable to the Department of Ecology, (at \$5.00 per year, this would bring each project current until **December 1, 2004**). Any payments of extension fees are non-refundable regardless whether the extension is granted.


