NOTICE OF DECLARATIONS OF CLAIM OF RIGHT TO WITHDRAW GROUND WATER NOS. 681 and 682.
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company of Tacoma, Washington, on March 25, 1948, filed with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, Olympia, Washington, two (2) declarations of claim of vested rights existing prior to June 7, 1945 to withdraw public ground waters in Thurston County, as follows:

Declaration No. 681 to withdraw 200 gallons per minute, 300 acre-feet per year, by means of a pump well located within the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 27, Twp. 16 N., Rge. 1 E.W.M., used continuously each year for the purpose of industrial and domestic supply, and fire protection, with priority (date of first beneficial use of water) of January, 1928; Declaration No. 682 to withdraw 100 gallons per minute, 80 acre-feet per year, by means of a pump well located within Lot 2 of Sec. 17, Twp. 19 N., Rge. 1 W.W.M., used continuously each year for industrial supply, with priority of August, 1928, and Claimant has requested Certificates of Ground Water Rights under such claims. Any person, firm or corporation disputing such claims or protesting that the rights claimed are not vested rights to be recognized under Chap. 263 of the 1945 Session Laws of the State of Washington, may file with the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, at Olympia, Washington, such objections or representations, in writing, as he may desire to make within thirty (30) days after date of last publication, which date is April 9, 1948.
