On **October 10, 2000**, we sent a letter reminding you of the need to file a Proof of Appropriation form or request an extension of time to put the water to full beneficial use on this project. Full beneficial use means the project is at full build out, all the water is in use, and the provisions of the permit have been met.

If you are using the full amount of water shown on your permit, please fill out the enclosed Proof of Appropriation form, have it notarized, and return it to this office. **The statutory recording fees are to be sent in as two separate remittances in the form of checks or money orders. Cash will NOT be accepted. Send both remittances to the Department of Ecology. Do not send the Proof of Appropriation form or fees if the water has not been put to full beneficial use.**

\$5.00 payable to the Department of Ecology
AND
\$9.00 payable to the **Mason** County Auditor

Also, the County Auditor is requiring that we have the parcel number(s) for the point of withdrawal/diversion and the place of use if different. Please send those numbers to us with your recording fees.


By following the above instruction, your final water right will be prepared, sent to your County Auditor for recording, and then forwarded to you by your County Auditor.

If more time is required to put the water to full use, you should request an extension of time in writing. By statute, a **\$5.00 fee per year must accompany such a request, together with a showing of good cause why your extension should be granted and a report of progress made during the last year.** The Proof of Appropriation for your water right permit was due on **October 1, 1997**. If an extension is needed, please send **\$25.00** payable to the Department of Ecology along with your request to extend your file until **October 1, 2002**.

If we do not hear from you within **sixty (60) days** from the receipt of this letter, we shall be forced to assume that you are no longer interested in retaining the permit, and action will be taken resulting in cancellation.

Thank you for returning my call and informing me of your current address and phone number. As I mentioned in my message, we are reviewing and updating our water right files. While reviewing the progress of the above-referenced permit, I noticed the permit is currently in the Completion of Construction stage of development. This letter is to remind you that the permit development schedule required that construction be completed on the water system on or before **October 1, 1996**, and that you notify this office that construction has been complete (please notice the development schedule on the back of the permit). Please complete the enclosed Completion of Construction form and submit it to this office as soon as possible if you have completed construction on the water system.

If you have not completed construction and are still interested in developing your project, you may request an extension of time. Since state law requires that the project be pursued with diligence and that good cause be shown before an extension can be granted, your extension request must be made in writing and contain the following:

1. A description of efforts you have made to complete construction on the project since the permit issued or the last extension was granted.
2. A time schedule for completing the project and developing the system.
3. Reason(s) for needing the extension.
4. Any additional remarks concerning your project that will assist us in making our decision of whether to grant the extension.
5. Check or money order for the **\$20.00** extension fee made payable to the Department of Ecology, (this would bring you current until **October 1, 2000**). Any payments of extension fees are non-refundable regardless whether the extension is granted.

Please submit the Completion of Construction form or the request for extension with the extension fee within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. This office should be notified if you no longer intend to develop the project. If you have any questions or concerns about any of this information, please call me at (360) 407-0290. Thank you for your attention to this matter.







SITE SECTION 1"=20' & 2" CONTOURS

(COUNTY BEARINGS, SIDE = S; PEAK = S; FRONT REP. CON.)




SITE PLAN 1"=100'
