Dear Mr. Jones:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reason(s) below:

You were required to be out of state for your job for an extended period of time and were unable to work on the project. Now that you are back in state, you are making progress on the project.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **September 30, 2013**.

You have a right to appeal this decision. To appeal this you must:

- File your appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board within 30 days of the “date of receipt” of this document. Filing means actual receipt by the Board during regular office hours.
- Serve your appeal on the Department of Ecology within 30 days of the “date of receipt” of this document. Service may be accomplished by any of the procedures identified in WAC 371-08-305(10). “Date of receipt” is defined at RCW 43.21B.001(2).

Be sure to do the following:

- Include a copy of the document that you are appealing.
- Serve and file your appeal in paper form; electronic copies are not accepted.
