PROVISIONS

Nothing in this permit shall be construed as excusing the permittee from compliance with any applicable federal, state, or local statutes, ordinances, or regulations including those administered by local agencies under the Shoreline Management Act of 1971.

Diversions intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than .125 (1/8) inch.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Issuance of this permit was based on sufficient waters available, at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the permittee that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

All diversions shall cease when the flow of Hines/Woodland Creek falls to 1.5 cubic feet per second as measured at the outlet of Long Lake.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
