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
PROVISIONS

It is noted that the construction of the facilities for the appropriation of water under this permit will require removal of material from or adjacent to a stream channel or watercourse. Permittee is, therefore, advised that a Hydraulic Approval should be obtained from the Departments of Fisheries and Game prior to commencing work (Fisheries Code 75.20.100).

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
