PROVISIONS

The installation of an access port as described in Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 shall be required prior to issuance of final certificate of water right.

In no instance shall the total annual quantity withdrawn and/or diverted under the existing rights exceed 16.0 acre-feet per year for domestic purposes.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
