PROVISIONS

"Lawn and garden irrigation shall cease when the flow to Tarboo Creek falls below 3.0 cfs as measured at the road culvert located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, T. 28 N., R. 1 W.W.M. This minimum flow has been tentatively established from recommendation of the Departments of Fisheries and Game and not by existing statutory procedures. Therefore, at such time as minimum flows are established on this stream in accordance with Chapter 90.22 RCW, this permit shall be conditioned to the extent of the new setting, provided that, under no conditions shall the permittee be subjected to a low flow requirement of greater than 3.0 cubic feet per second at the above-referenced gage."

*The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.*

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
