PROVISIONS


"If any interference should be noted in surrounding wells, an aquifer test will be performed by Domsea Farms to establish the nature or extent of the interference.

The access port shall be maintained at all times on the well (s).

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
