LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

A part of Section 18, T. 16 N., R. 1 E. W. M. described as follows: Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Turner Road as located in the plat of Lazy "T" Estates as per map recorded in Book 15 of Plats, at pages 39 and 40, records of Thurston County Auditor, said point being North 16°26'56" West 793.36 feet from the intersection of said West line and the South line of said Section 18; thence North 16°26'56" West 161.23 feet; thence North 26°10'55" West 456 feet more or less to the North line of the SE₁SW₄ of Section 18; thence West along said North line 292.44 feet; thence South parallel to the West line of said subdivision 561.63 feet; thence South 89°42'01" East 554.34 feet to the point of beginning.

PROVISIONS

Installation and maintenance of an access port as described in Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 is required. An air line and gauge may be installed in addition to the access port.

Permittee is advised that notice of proof of appropriation of water (under which final certificates of water right issues) should not be filed until the permanent diversion facilities have been installed together with a mainline system capable of delivering the recommended quantity of water to an existing or proposed distribution system within the area to be served.

All water wells constructed within the state shall meet the minimum standards for construction and maintenance as provided under RCW 18.104 (Washington Water Well Construction Act of 1971) and Chapter 173-160 WAC (Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells.)

Owing to the proximity of neighboring wells, the permittee is reminded of his responsibility towards same and advised that he may be required to regulate his withdrawal pumping rate if existing rights are injuriously affected.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
