The West 215.65 feet of that part of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, T. 19 N., R. 1 W.W.M., lying Northerly of county road known as Old South Bay Road, EXCEPTING THEREFROM a tract described as beginning at a point 1,851.70 feet North and 2,741.70 feet East of the SW corner of said Sec. 32 and running thence North 140 feet, East 150 feet and South 45°55' West 205.2 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING ALSO that part lying South and West of a line described as beginning at a point on the West line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 329.61 feet North of its SW corner and running thence East 230.65 feet and South 75 feet, more or less to said road;

AND EXCEPTING ALSO county road known as South Bay Road and West 15 feet for county road known as Sleater-Kinney Road.

PROVISIONS

Water users should understand that quantities recommended and the number of acres to be irrigated may be reduced at the time of issuance of a final water right commensurate with the capacity of the installed system and the number of acres actually irrigated.

A well log of the completed well shall be submitted by the driller to the Department of Ecology within thirty (30) days of completion of this well. This well log shall be complete and all information concerning the static water level in the completed well, in addition to any pump test data, shall be submitted as it is obtained.

"Appropriation of public waters in Thurston County are subject to the provisions of Chapter 173-591 Washington Administrative Code, The Reservation of Future Public Water Supply for Thurston County. Reserved waters have a priority date of August 13, 1986. Water rights developed under authority of this permit may be subject to regulation in favor of reserved rights."

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
