PROVISIONS

The installation of an access port as described in Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 shall be required prior to issuance of final certificate of water right.

"All water wells constructed within the state shall meet the minimum standards for construction and maintenance as provided under RCW 18.104 (Washington Water Well Construction Act of 1971) and Chapter 173-160 WAC (Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells)."

In no instance shall the total annual quantity withdrawn under all existing rights exceed 220 acre-feet per year for irrigation purposes.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
