Certificate of Ground Water Right

Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 229, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 of Thurston County
of Olympia, Washington, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of
the ground waters of a well
located within HOUSEBANK
Sec. 15, Twp. 16 N., R. 1 W. W. M.
for the purpose of municipal supply
under and subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. 4457 issued by the State
Supervisor of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been perfected
in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water
Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 8 at page 3577-A;
that the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1957; that the quantity of ground
water under the right hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually
beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 300 gallons per minute; 400 acre-
foot per year for municipal supply.

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Thompson Place and Tanglowilde, Thurston County, Washington.

The right to the use of the ground water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
