Certificate of Ground Water Right

Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 203, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That LORNE and ESTHER BERGER
of Olympia, Washington, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of
the ground waters of a well
located within G. A. Agnew Donation Land Claim No. 67
Sec. 1, Twp. 18 N., R. 2 W. W. M.,
for the purpose of irrigation and domestic supply
under and subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. 5036 issued by the State
Supervisor of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been perfected
in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water
Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 8 at page 3729-A;
that the right hereby confirmed dates from July 21, 1959; that the quantity of ground
water under the right hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually
beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 45 gallons per minute; 12.6 acre-
feet per year for the irrigation of 3.5 acres and for domestic supply.

Special provisions required by the Supervisor of Water Resources:

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant:

A portion of the G.A. Agnew Donation Land Claim No. 67, sec. 1, T. 18 N., R. 2 W. W. M., described as follows: Commencing 1547.23 feet north of the southeast corner of said donation claim, thence run north 606.12 feet; thence west 316.93 feet; thence south 606.12 feet; thence east 316.93 feet to the point of beginning, less the east 15 feet thereof for road.

The right to the use of the ground water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
