Certificate of Ground Water Right

Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 203, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That ALVIN H. THOMPSON

of Olympia, Washington

has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the ground waters of a well

located within NEANW1/4

Sec. 14, Twp. 16 N., R. 1 W. W. M.,

for the purpose of community domestic supply

under and subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. 5976 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been perfected

in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 9 at page 4344-A;

that the right hereby confirmed dates from June 29, 1962; that the quantity of ground water under the right hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually

beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 100 gallons per minute; 160 acre-feet per year for community domestic supply.

Special provisions required by the Supervisor of Water Resources: This certificate is issued supplemental to rights existing under Certificates Nos. 1688-A and 3577-A which total 704 acre-feet per year for a community with an estimated requirement of 672 acre-feet per year.

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant:

Community of Tanglewilde, Thurston County, Washington.

The right to the use of the ground water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
