CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 127, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that **KING COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**
of King State of Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
of the waters of Chappel Springs, a tributary of Boise Creek
with point or points of diversion within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Sec. 29 Twp 20 N. R. 7 E. W. M. under and subject to provisions contained in
Appropriation Permit No. 3570 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
record in Volume 11 at Page 527 on the 27th day of February, 1951
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is September 2, 1940; that the
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

0.20 of a cubic foot per second for the purposes of
domestic supply and the irrigation of 30 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Sec. 29, Twp. 20 N., Rge. 7 E., S. 1., and running
south along the west line of said Section 293.5 feet, more or less, to the south boundary
line of the right-of-way of State Road No. 5, as now located, which is the true point of
beginning of this description, then south along the west line of said Section 29, 150.0
feet; then in an easterly direction on a curve to the right having a radius of 1232.5
feet a distance of 615.0 feet, more or less; thence North 37°51' East along the radius
of a 4° curve a distance of 150.0 feet, more or less, to the Engineer's Station 86+22.0
point on the south boundary line of the right-of-way of State Road No. 5; then south-
easterly along said boundary line 400 feet, more or less; then south 925.0 feet, more
or less; thence west 660.00 feet, more or less; then south 330.0 feet, more or less;
then west 330.0 feet, more or less; then north 400 feet, more or less; then west 330
feet, more or less, on a line which shall be parallel to the south line of Northeast
quarter of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, Twp. 20 N., Rge. 7 E., S. 1.; then north 330 feet, more or
less; then west along the south line of the foresaid NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, 990 feet,
more or less, to the quarter corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 29, then north along the
west line of the foresaid NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, 490.9 feet, more or less; thence
South 69°35' West 293.5 feet, more or less; then North 10°19' East 467.0 feet, more or
less; then South 75°51' East 343 feet, more or less; then North 10°19' East 290 feet,
more or less, to the south boundary line of the right-of-way of State Road No. 5, then
along said south boundary line to the true point of beginning; less portions used for
county roads.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
