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PROVISIONS

The amount of water granted is a maximum limit that shall not be exceeded and the water user shall be entitled only to that amount of water within the specified limit that is beneficially used.

This authorization to make use of public waters of the state is subject to existing rights, including any existing rights held by the United States for the benefit of Indians under treaty or otherwise.

A certificate of water right will not be issued until a final examination is made.

All withdrawal for lawn and garden irrigation shall cease when the flow of the river at Dartford (river mile 10.8) falls to or below those flows given in the following table:

The management and regulation shall be accomplished in accordance with the Water Resources Management Program, Little Spokane River Basin, August 1975 and WAC 173-555 effective January 6, 1976.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or fail to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
