is, pursuant to the Report of Examination which has been accepted by the applicant, hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public surface waters of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights and to the limitations and provisions set out herein.

Priority date of this permit is March 29, 1971

Source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed springs

tributary of Baird Cove

The quantity of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially applied and not to exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second, 10 1/2 acre-feet per year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, to be used for the following purposes: irrigation and frost protection, as more definitely set out below.

The approximate point (s) of diversion is 300 feet west and 1100 feet north from the south quarter corner of Sec. 4

being within NE 1/4 SW 1/4

of Sec. 4, Twp. 19 N., Rge. 1 E. W.M., Thurston County.

The use, or uses, to which water is to be applied:

Domestic/municipal supply _____ cubic feet per second, _____ acre-feet per year, during entire year.

Irrigation: 0.11 cubic feet per second, 10 1/2 acre-feet per year from May 1 to October 1 each year, for irrigation of 7 1/2 acres.

Other use(s) frost protection; _____ cubic feet per second, _____ acre-feet per year, as needed each year.
