is, pursuant to the Report of Examination which has been accepted by the applicant, hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public ground waters of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights and to the limitations and provisions set out herein.

Priority date of this permit is July 21, 1979

Source(s) of the proposed ground water appropriation is/are a well

The quantity of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially applied and not to exceed 200 gallons per minute; 2 acre-feet per year, to be used for the following purposes: domestic supply and industrial use

, as more definitely set out below.

being within 1/4 section

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

For Domestic Supply

That part of the 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 12 N., R. 2 E.W.M. lying southerly of the high water line of Mayfield Reservoir and southerly of a line bearing north 33°30' east from the northeast corner of Government Lot 3 of said Section.

For Industrial Use

The 1/4 Government Lot 1, Sec. 20; and Government Lot 1, Sec. 20, within T. 12 N., R. 2 E.W.M.

ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS: The installation and maintenance of an access port as described in Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 shall be required prior to issuance of final Certificate of Water Right.

Issued as a primary right for the (2) acre-foot per year and as a supplemental supply to Ground Water Certificate Number 600 for two acre-foot per year. The total water demand will not exceed eight (8) acre-foot per year less any quantity in excess of six acre-foot per year withdrawn under the above ground water certificate.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS:

The well will be drilled and have a diameter of 8 inches, and depth of 200 feet.
