RE: Technical Advisory Group Openings

The State Building Code Council (Council) is beginning the review of the 2018 model codes. The review period for the International Building Code and Fire Code, and the commercial Washington State Energy Code, (Group 1 codes) commences this month. The technical advisory groups (TAGs) will review significant changes in the model codes, and consider state amendments to the codes for final adoption. The Group 1 TAGs will conduct 1-2 meetings per month through June 2018, before making recommendations to the Council.
